



Brush and yard waste pickup will be offered to Village of Hammond residents beginning *Monday, April 12, 2010*

Please note there are a couple of changes this year:

1. **Yard waste will only be accepted when placed in 30 gallon, natural Kraft wet strength compost bags.**

Bags can be obtained at the village clerk's office located at 455 Davis St. in the upper level starting Monday, March 29th. Bags are sold in bundles of 5 at a cost of \$2.50 per bundle including tax. Bags may also be purchased if available from local hardware stores.

**No plastic bags of any type will be accepted.**

2. Brush will need to be tied in bundles no larger than 1' X 6' and placed by the curb.

**\*Brush will not be picked up if it is not bundled and tied.**

**\*Brush must be at the curb by 8am, Monday.**

The compost and brush sites have been changed from the previous location to the Public Works site located at 1630 Thayer St. At this time residents **will not** be able to bring trucks or trailer to this site to unload as the roads to these areas are not adequate for use. As soon as weather permits roads to the two sites will be constructed and residents will be allowed to drop off brush and yard waste. Drop-off hours will be weekdays from 7:00 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. A notice will be placed with your utility bill when the site is functional for resident use.
