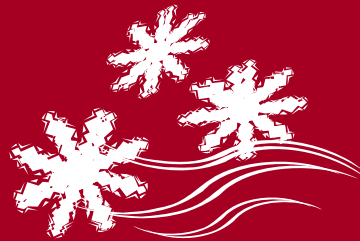

2011 PROPERTY TAXES

The 2011 property tax statements will be mailed in mid-December. The Clerk's Office will be collecting payments Monday-Friday, 8:00am – 4:30pm through January 31st, 2012. If you cannot make it to the Clerk's Office during these hours please call us to make other arrangements at 715-796-2727.

Should you only choose to pay the first half of your taxes by January 31st; the second payment will be collected at the St. Croix County Treasurer's Office at the Government Center in Hudson. Tax payments can be made using a credit card online, via phone, or at the Clerk's Office. There is a fee to use this service. Call the Clerk's Office or check out our website for details www.hammondwi.org.

If you would like a copy of your tax payment receipt, please contact the Clerk's Office or go to the St. Croix County website to view your payment history.

FROM THE PUBLIC WORKS DEPARTMENT

SNOW PLOWING

Snow plowing is scheduled at the discretion of the Public Works Director. The Public Works Department will make every effort to clear the streets and make them safe for travel as soon as possible following a snow or ice event. Per village ordinance, the village is not responsible for any damage to anything that is placed, planted or built in the village right-of-way. **This includes but is not limited to turf, mailboxes, flowers, trees.** The village right-of-way consists of the area approximately 15 feet from the curb.

CLEARING SIDEWALKS

Per Village ordinance, the owner or occupant of any lot or parcel shall, within 24 hours of a snowfall, remove all snow and ice which may have fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of such lot or parcel. If the owner or occupant fails to comply, the village will remove the snow or ice and the cost will be charged back to the homeowner.

DEPOSITING SNOW ON VILLAGE PROPERTY

No person shall cause snow to be deposited on boulevards, sidewalks, streets or avenues or any other village owned property without permission from the village. Payment of a fee sufficient to reimburse the village for the cost of removing any snow so deposited without permission may be required.
